

PROCEDURE

Photographs

During your child/children's time at The Mead Community Primary School, we may wish to use photographs or images for the purpose of displays, creating class books or for publicising or promoting school activities. This may include pictures taken of school fetes and fairs, fundraising events, musical events, theatrical events such as school plays and other activities, class photos, sports days and lessons (including PE classes).

You will need to give your consent to the school for the use images or photographs taken by the school or an authorised agent of the school, which will be used to promote or publicise school activities or be stored in the school archives. The school is only responsible for photographs taken by the school or an authorised agent of the school and cannot be responsible for photographs taken by third parties (such as parents).

The media is not subject to the Data Protection Act, or these guidelines and the school cannot prohibit the media from taking pictures or using the names of any child, however we endeavour to liaise closely with the local press to agree acceptable images of school activities.

If at a future time you should choose to withdraw your consent you would need to do so in writing to the school. Please note that we will not be able to remove images of your child or children from historic publications or archived materials.
